After its Worldwide Premiere at the Arthur Miller Theater at the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, the one person play *Mrs. Kelly's Journey Home*, starring Breeda Miller, has been playing to sold-out audiences in Michigan including Detroit, Manchester, Trenton, Brighton, Saline, and Traverse City. Breeda has returned the play to Chicago twice, and just finished a run in Tampa and Vero Beach. She will soon be performing in Atlanta and in September she is booked in Ireland! This play is a theatrical memoir with humor and touching moments, with Breeda Miller performing each role, introducing us to her parents, their families and friends. *Mrs. Kelly's Journey Home* keeps audiences riveted from the opening line to the closing blessing. It is a moving, joyous exploration of love, roots and family. In 2022 Breeda received the *Wilde Award* for the best one-person play in Michigan. This play especially resonates with anyone involved in eldercare, either as a professional or as a family member of someone experiencing dementia.








# 2023 Dues
